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Footnotes: Students Must Submit Revised ADP's if Deviation from the Planned Program is approved due by **April 1** each year. 1) The base requirement of 80 credits for an M.A. and 123 credits for the doctorate in clinical psychology may be reduced by course waiver or acceptance. The MA. Degree is a nested degree within the doctoral program. All hours are doctoral hours including those satisfying the nested M.A. degree. 2) Students who have not completed a proposal defense by the end of PSY 718 must sign up for 1 hour of PSY 719, Proposal Continuance, each semester until the proposal is completed. 3) Students who have not completed a dissertation defense by the end of PSY 703 must sign up for 1 hour of PSY 704, Dissertation Continuance, each semester until the dissertation has been successfully submitted to the library for publication. 4) All students who are requesting courses from prior graduate work to be transferred and/or waived must complete the course transfer & acceptance form by the end of their 1st semester in the program. Transferred courses cannot have been used for a previous degree. 5) Related electives for specialty concentrations are determined by the track mentor. See handbook for concentration courses.
